

**Ordinance No. 593**

**An ordinance repealing § 1-6-4 of the Akron Municipal Code, providing for the appointment of a Public Works Director by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Akron, Colorado**

WHEREAS, the Town of Akron, in the County of Washington, State of Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the “Town,” is a body corporate operating as a statutory town pursuant to the general statutes of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, § 31-15-201 gives the governing bodies of municipalities the authority regarding municipal administrative matters, including over the municipalities’ employees; and

WHEREAS, § 1-6-4 of the Akron Municipal Code provides for the appointment of the Town’s Public Works Director by the Board of Trustees, hereinafter referred to as the “Board.”

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the Town’s Public Works Director should no longer be appointed by the Board pursuant to the Akron Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is necessary and proper to repeal and rescind § 1-6-4 of the Akron Municipal Code, providing for the appointment of the Town Public Works Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF AKRON, COLORADO:

That § 1-6-4 of the Akron Municipal Code is hereby rescinded and repealed.

Following adoption, this Ordinance shall be authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and the Town Clerk and shall be recorded in the Town of Akron book of ordinances. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication as required by law.
