

Ordinance No. 569

An ordinance amending Section 6-7B-5(D) of the Akron Municipal Code pertaining to Impoundment, Redemption, and Disposal of Cats.

WHEREAS, the Akron Municipal Code establishes a procedure whereby impounded unclaimed cats may be disposed upon five-day's notice; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Town of Akron has determined that, in order to mitigate the existence of feral cats within the Town of Akron, it is necessary and proper to amend the Akron Municipal Code to delete that five-day notice period before which unclaimed cats may be disposed of.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Akron that Section 6-7B-5(D) of the Akron Municipal Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“D. Disposal of Stray Cats. If it is determined by the Town Clerk or the Town Clerk’s authorized representative that a cat is a stray and has become a public nuisance, the cat may be disposed of at the direction of the Town Clerk or the Town Clerk’s authorized representative. For purposes of this provision, any animal control officer of the Town shall be an authorized representative of the Town Clerk.”

Except as amended herein, all other provisions of the Akron Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing Ordinance #569 was presented a motion for its adoption was made by Trustee Derek Glosson. The motion was seconded by Trustee Jared Jefferson and upon roll call vote of 6 yes and 0 no, the motion was passed.
